Conditions:

1. The final will be limited to the ten (10) highest lifetime money earners, as determined by Standardbred Canada records, amongst those that enter as of the published declaration date and time.

2. The next ten (10) highest lifetime money earners that enter, as determined by Standardbred Canada records, will be eligible to the consolation (\$65,000 E). If a consolation can be filled with sufficient wagering interests, that may be raced for 10% of the total purse pool before entry fees are added and the main event will race for 90% of the total purse pool before entry fees are added. Entry fee for the consolation will be \$1,000 CAD. Any horse that is declared for this race but does not draw in either event due to the above condition (including a horse drawn as also eligible that does not draw into the race) and meets the track's qualifying standards for the race will have their nomination and sustaining fees refunded in full and shall NOT be liable for the entry fee.

3. There will be one (1) "also eligible" drawn for the final and consolation. Those designated as "also eligible" in the final will be drawn into the consolation, but may be eligible to be drawn into the final at scratch time. Horses may not opt out of their proper races to enter the next level down.

4. If a horse entered fails to be amongst the top ten (10) lifetime money earners and the consolation doesn't fill, all payments will be refunded to the owner of the horse at time of declaration, provided, however, the horse meets the current qualifying standards at Woodbine Mohawk Park. If a horse entered fails to be amongst the top twenty (20) lifetime money earners, all payments will be refunded to the owner of the horse at time of declaration, provided, however, the horse meets the current qualifying standards at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

5. A minimum of eight (8) eligible entries are required for a consolation to be contested.

6. All nominations, sustaining, and starting monies will be added to the total purse.

7. Woodbine Entertainment reserves the right to invite foreign horses to enter and race in the Maple Leaf Trot. Invited foreign horses must pay a fee of \$9,500 Canadian. (This fee is comprised of \$500 Nomination, \$4,000 Sustaining and \$5,000 Starting) Invited foreign horses must declare and pay this fee to the Mohawk race office staff no later than 10:30 a.m. Monday, August 31, 2020. Foreign horses are those horses which normally race outside of Canada and the United States and have not had more than four starts in North America in 2020.

8. Horses may be supplemented to the Maple Leaf Trot by paying a supplemental fee of \$40,000 Canadian funds. Supplemental fees and declarations must be submitted to the Mohawk race office staff no later than 10:30 a.m. on Monday, August 31, 2020. Supplemental fees must be paid by certified check, bank draft or money order, and made payable to Woodbine Entertainment. If a horse is supplemented and is not in the top ten (10) money earners, the supplement fee will be returned and horse is not eligible for the consolation

Purse Distribution:

All finishers in the race will receive money. The winner of the race will receive 50% of the total purse.

One percent (1%) of the total purse will be paid to each horse finishing sixth through last; the remainder of the purse for the race will be divided 50-24-16-10% for the horses finishing second through fifth.
